TOPIC

It is often the case that firms do not have control over the price of key inputs they use. For example, pharmaceutical companies often use petrochemicals, but they have no control over the world market price for crude oil. If the cost of a key input rises, can the firm pass those higher production costs along to consumers in the form of higher prices? Critically discuss.
